 - Amore Event Center (Broomfield)
 - 6 hour rental, Room, buffet meal (choose food style), drinks, tables/chairs, setup, cleanup, sound/AV, photobooth all provided by event center (Capacity of 250)
 - We would have to provide center pieces and dessert.
 - \$3100 based on 200 people (\$15.50 per person)
 - Discussion took place regarding pricing (i.e. What if we had less than 200 people, will we still only be charged \$15.50/person? How much do we charge each person and how much does booster club cover? Is this more cost than we want to incur?)
 - Westminster Rec Center
 - Room, tables/chairs provided
 - We would have to provide setup/cleanup, sound/AV, food (if desired), plates, utensils, table coverings
 - \$90 per hour, Can only book 90 days out from event – February 15
 - Discussion took place regarding food (i.e. Will meal have to be catered or can we bring in own food? Do we want to have a meal?)
- With either option: if a meal is served, we will need people to RSVP and prepay
- Topic was tabled as no clear cut decision could be made
 - *N. Shade will check on catering prices through Wishbone Restaurant*
 - *P. Keeney will check with Amore Event Center on pricing if we have less than 200 people.*
 - *K. Presser will get feedback from school administration on two options*
