

Bible 10: Jesus, our Perfect Substitute and the Early Christian Church

During semester 1 and the first part of semester 2 we will be studying the life of Jesus. The final portion of semester 2 we will study the book of Acts.

The unit titles are as follows: The Baby in the Manger is the Savior, The Savior Begins His Work, Jesus Calls His Disciples, Jesus Performs Miracles, Jesus Teaches with Parables, Jesus Teaches about God's Will, Jesus Teaches about Enemies of Faith, Jesus' Passion, Jesus' Exaltation, The Outpouring of the Holy Spirit, the Beginnings of the New Testament Church, and The Good News Spreads to the Nations.

You will need an NIV Bible, a notebook, pen or pencil, and a folder in which to keep handouts.

We will be doing various projects and assignments dealing with our lessons throughout the year as well as having a great deal of discussion in small groups and with the class as a whole. The participation of you as an individual will enhance the class for you and your classmates. We will be committing to memory a number of Bible passages that relate to the truths of the lessons we study.

It is my prayer that our study of God's Word will strengthen the faith of each of you and serve as a springboard for you to share the good news with others.
