We are committed to carrying out our mission to educate the total student in a caring, Christian, family community. At RMLHS, spiritual matters are more than a class or a daily devotion. Lessons from God's Word are an integral part of everything we teach and do. We realize that you might not be familiar with who we are or the spiritual nature of what we will teach your son/daughter. Below is a basic outline of what we believe and teach.

We believe...

- The Bible is the true word of God. It clearly teaches all we need to know for eternal life as well as a guide for our life here on earth.
- There is only one true God. In the Bible, God reveals himself as three persons - Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.
- At the beginning of time, God created heaven, earth, and all things. He did this in six days. Man and woman are God's special creation. God's plan is that a marriage includes one man and one woman.
- The first people, Adam and Eve, lost the image of God when they gave in to the temptation of Satan and disobeyed God's command. This brought on them God's judgment.
